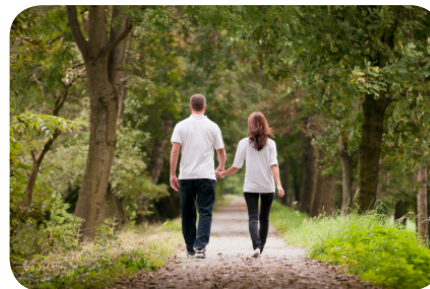


Website
