Vision testing



Can you say or sign names of pictures?

The nurse will cover one of your eyes to test your vision



Seeing the doctor



Please sit and wait.



The doctor will call your name and talk to you about your eyes.

Testing Intraocular pressure



The doctor will ask you to look straight ahead. Please sit still. Some machines blow a puff of air into your eye or touch your eye gently. It feels strange, but this test needs to be done.



Eye drops



These are the eye drops.



The doctor may ask to put drops in your eyes. The drops will make you blink.

Waiting



The eye drops will take about 20 minutes to work



Please sit and wait.

Slit-Lamp examination



The doctor will ask you to come into their room again.



The doctor will ask you to sit at a special machine, like this. You will see a bright light.





The doctor may touch your eye lid.



Optometry examination



The optometrist will place special glasses on your face.





The optometrist will use a bright light to look at your eye.

Orthoptic examination



The orthoptist will ask you to look at the light or an object.



The orthoptist may ask you to look through a special window bar.

Ophthalmic Imaging



The doctor may ask you to sit at this special camera.



The doctor will ask you to place your chin on a shelf. You will need to keep your head still for a short while.





You will see a blue light.

The doctor may give you a prescription form for eye drops.



Please give this prescription form to the hospital Pharmacy chemist.
