

Introducing the Macmillan Personalised Care Support Worker Team

The role of a Macmillan Personalised Care Support Worker

We support all of the clinical nurse specialist (CNS) teams in the different cancer specialities at Lister Hospital. We create a Holistic Needs Assessment (HNA) and care plan for patients at their time of diagnosis, during treatment or at any stage throughout the cancer experience.

What is a Holistic Needs Assessment (HNA) and Care Plan?

A HNA is a simple questionnaire to identify your concerns or needs. These could be emotional, physical, psychological and spiritual. You will be asked to rate how important these concerns are to you. The concerns are then discussed with you over the phone or face to face.

Your CNS team, in collaboration with the Macmillan personalised care support workers, will develop a personalised care and support plan. The care plan will record suggestions and action to help you manage your concerns and signpost you to other services that may be able to support you.

When your care plan is completed, a copy will be sent to you, your GP and a copy uploaded to your healthcare record. This will be on the Macmillan portal which is a secure website.

You can ask for a review of your care plan or request a new assessment at any time.
