# Who are the clinical nurse specialists (CNS) for lung cancer?

The CNSs are trained nurses specialising in the area of lung cancer and any associated issues.

In East & North Hertfordshire NHS Trust, the role of CNS also includes support for patients and their family when a cancer is suspected but not confirmed.

Your CNS is also known as your key worker.

### How can the lung CNS help me?

Lung CNSs are experienced nurses and understand the fears and anxieties that patients and their families have when a suspicion of, or diagnosis of cancer has been made.

They work closely with you from diagnosis and throughout your cancer journey. They are here to support you and your family by:

- answering your questions
- advising and supporting you on emotional, physical, financial, social and spiritual issues
- helping you fully explore your treatment choices
- talking through with you any issues concerning your quality of life, related to your health before and after treatment
- supporting you on finishing treatment and any on-going issues

liaising and introducing you to other members of the care team who could support and advise you, i.e. dietician, social worker, district nurse etc.

# Will the hospital CNS visit me at home?

No. They work very closely with the community Macmillan nurses, Isobel nurse specialist nurses and district nurses who work in your local area. If necessary, with your consent, they will refer you to their care. This means that all your needs will be met by the team closest to your home.

### Is my confidentiality protected?

Yes. Confidentiality is protected at all times. They recognise that each patient and their family will have their own personal needs and that these will be different from one person to another.

All contacts will be treated with the strictest confidentiality and will only be discussed with another member of the team if you agree.

### What if I have a problem out of hours?
