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# What is the Multidisciplinary Diagnostic Centre (MDC)?

The MDC is a clinic that has been set up to investigate vague symptoms that may be a sign of a number of conditions, including cancer.

## Why have I been referred urgently to the MDC?

You have been referred to the MDC at Lister Hospital because your GP feels your symptoms urgently need further investigation. There are many conditions your symptoms may be linked to, including the possibility of cancer.

### Does this mean I have cancer?

Having an urgent referral does not necessarily mean you have cancer. Most people who have an urgent referral don't have cancer. You have been referred because you need to see a specialist or have some investigations done quickly to help find out what is wrong with you.

> You will need to be available for diagnostic tests in the next two weeks and attend on the date given

#### What happens next?

Please check that your GP Practice has your current contact details, including your mobile phone number (if you have one) and your correct postal address.

The hospital will call you to arrange a telephone clinic appointment with the MDC nurse specialist to go through your symptoms.

Your case will then be discussed with the MDC consultant and you will receive a telephone call from the MDC nurse specialist updating you about the plan going forward. We aim to see you in clinic post investigations but you may get a call asking you to come to clinic before this if a face to face review is needed.

### Your appointment

Once you have been given your appointment to see the MDC consultant, it is very important that you attend. Please call the MDC nurse specialist **immediately** if you are unable to keep your appointment, you will then need to arrange an alternative appointment.

### Your test results

The results arising from any investigations will be discussed with you and explained. If no cause for your symptoms can be found, you will be referred back to your GP. If you are diagnosed with cancer, you will be given the relevant information by the hospital and referred to the appropriate consultant. You will also receive details of any further information and support you may need.
