# Who are the clinical nurse specialists (CNS) for upper gastrointestinal cancer?

The CNSs are trained nurses specialising in the area of upper gastrointestinal oncology.

Some CNSs are also known as Macmillan nurses and are closely associated with the national organisation Macmillan Cancer Support. This organisation is devoted to helping patients and their families cope with the diagnosis, treatment and effects of cancer.

In East & North Hertfordshire NHS Trust, the role of the CNS also includes support for patients and their family when a cancer is suspected, but not confirmed.

Your CNS is also known as your key worker.

# How can the upper gastrointestinal CNS help me?

A CNS is an experienced nurse and understands the fears and anxieties that patients and their families have when a suspicion of, or diagnosis of upper gastrointestinal cancer has been made.

They work closely with you from diagnosis and throughout your cancer journey. They are here to support you and your family by:

- answering any questions
- advising and supporting you on emotional, physical, financial, social and spiritual issues

- help you to fully explore your treatment choices
- talk through any issues concerning your quality of life related to your health, before and after treatment
- support you on finishing treatment
- liaising and introducing you to other members of the care team who could support and advise you i.e. dietician, social worker, district nurse etc.

# Will the hospital CNS visit me at home?

No. They work very closely with the community Macmillan nurses and/or district nurses who work in your local area. If necessary, with your consent, they will refer you to their care. This means that all your needs will be met by the team closest to your home.

## Will my confidentiality be protected?

Yes. Confidentiality is maintained at all times. They recognise that each patient and their family will have their own personal needs and that these will be different from one person to another.

All contacts will be treated with the strictest confidentiality and will only be discussed with another member of the team if you agree.
