The Trust opened its new inpatient maternity service, the Diamond Jubilee Unit in October 2011. The unit brings together our midwifery- and consultant-led units.

#### Midwifery Led Unit (MLU)

You can choose to have your baby in our MLU and, providing things remain uncomplicated, after the birth of the baby you will be cared for in the same room until you are ready to go home, ideally within hours of the birth. Our MLU offers:

- 7 birthing rooms with en-suite bathrooms
- 2 birthing pools
- Home from home environment
- One to one care when in established labour
- Individual birthing plan

If you choose to use the midwife-led unit you have the reassurance of knowing that the new consultant-led unit is in the same building should you need additional medical care.

### **Consultant Led Unit (CLU)**

In the consultant-led unit, care is available to all women and is specifically tailored to those who might have higher risk pregnancies or an underlying medical condition. Our CLU offers:

- 9 birthing rooms with en-suite bathrooms
- 1 birthing pool
- Modern, comfortable purpose built rooms
- One to one care when in established labour
- Individual birthing plan

Whilst in the unit, you will receive care from a midwife in the same high quality environment and have all the consultant-led support you need. Following the birth of your baby you will transfer to the unit's postnatal ward.

Whichever unit you choose, you will be encouraged to use relaxation techniques to help you have the best birth experience possible. Appropriate pain relief is offered in both units, with epidurals available in the CLU.
